

Response to COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Pandemic

In guidance with government issued guidelines, it is important that we give due consideration to the recent Coronavirus threat. Day to day interaction with customers, suppliers and within our own team is vital to daily operation of our business. It is appropriate that we should always take reasonable precautions in terms of hygiene, paying particular attention during this time.

None of our staff have been to a cat 1 nor 2 area since first reports of the virus. Going forward, we obviously advise against travel to these countries and any staff that intend to do so have been instructed to make management aware before hand. Should this happen, this document will be updated.

Visitors to our offices in Glasgow and Warrington will be asked whether they have been to any affected area (cat 1 or 2) in the past 14 days, or if they have been in contact with anyone known to be carrying the virus or who is currently in a state of self-isolation.

If a visitor has been, specifically to a Cat 1 area or exposed to anyone carrying the virus or who is currently in a state of self-isolation, they will NOT be allowed access.

If they have been to a Cat 2 area, management will take a risk-based approach as to whether the visit is essential or not.

Both sites are already to subject to regular cleaning routines as part of normal activities. During this time, extra attention will be given to communal areas (door handles, kitchen areas, meeting rooms etc) which will be wiped down daily. In line with government guidelines, staff are asked to be extra cautious regarding personal hygiene and hand washing etc.

- Macau
- Malaysia
- Myanmar
- Singapore
- Taiwan
- Thailand
- Vietnam
