



Response to COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Pandemic

Update as of October 2021

Further to previously issued documents, we would like to offer an update to present operations within Fluidic.

I am pleased to report that none of our staff have contracted COVID19 to date. All staff are double vaccinated and carry out regular lateral flow tests. In addition, we have training programs, which all staff have undertaken and are aware of government regulations and how best to protect themselves, and others, from the virus.

As per government guidelines, we remained operational throughout lockdown (we are heavily involved in essential industry, including supply to power generation, pharmaceutical, hospitals and food/beverage manufacture). During the peaks of the pandemic, we maintained only a skeleton staff onsite with working from home the standard where possible. All staff have now returned to the office, with precautionary measures in place. Visitors are asked to carry out a coronavirus questionnaire and provide contact details (a QR code available at each site for track and trace).

If a visitor has been overseas or exposed to anyone carrying the virus within the past 14 days, or if they are currently in a state of self-isolation for any reason, they will NOT be allowed access.

Both sites are already subject to regular cleaning routines as part of normal activities. During this time, we continue to give extra attention to communal areas (door handles, kitchen areas, meeting rooms etc) which will be wiped down daily. In line with government guidelines, staff are asked to be extra cautious regarding personal hygiene and hand washing etc.
